Meet Salvador. Together, he and his daughter Pat have kept his COPD and other chronic illnesses at bay, then came COVID.

After consult with his doctor, they decided he would receive the best chance for a successful recovery with the CareMore Hospital @ Home program.

After evaluation he was prescribed supplemental oxygen, steroids and antibiotics. A plan was put in place and his respiratory status was monitored.

He received weekly face-to face visits from a dedicated Hospital @ Home nurse practitioner assigned to his case.

Salvador and Pat were able to keep his oxygen and medications on track while collaborating with the CareMore team to keep an eye on his respiration.


Success. His cough has improved, he no longer has shortness of breath. He's been discharged and will be followed by the palliative care team.

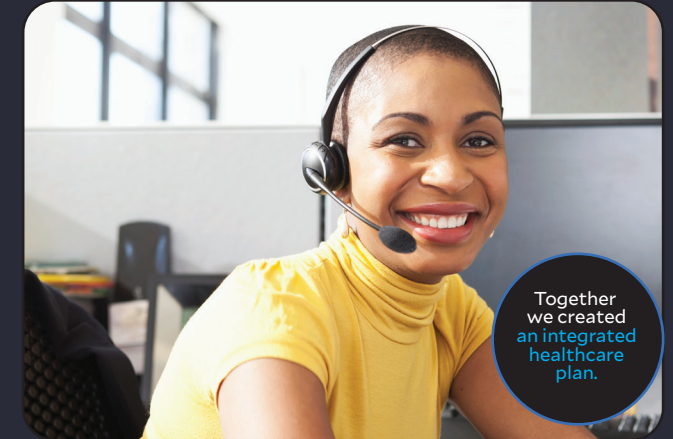

Salvador wanted at home care.

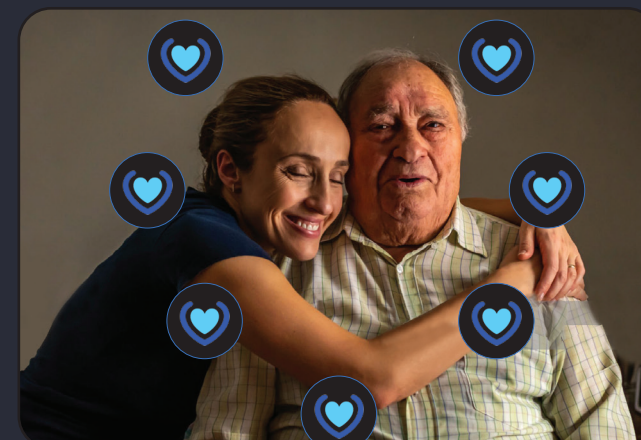
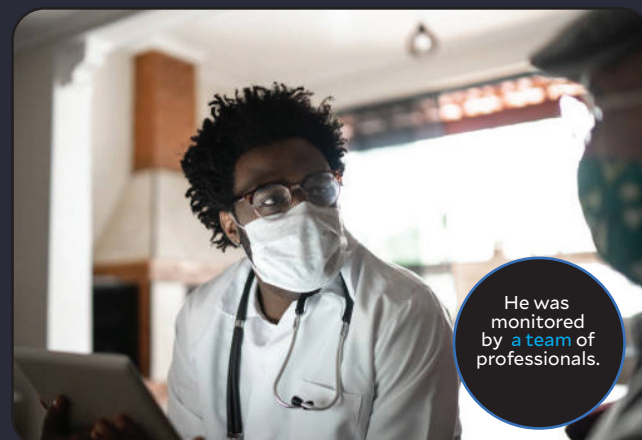

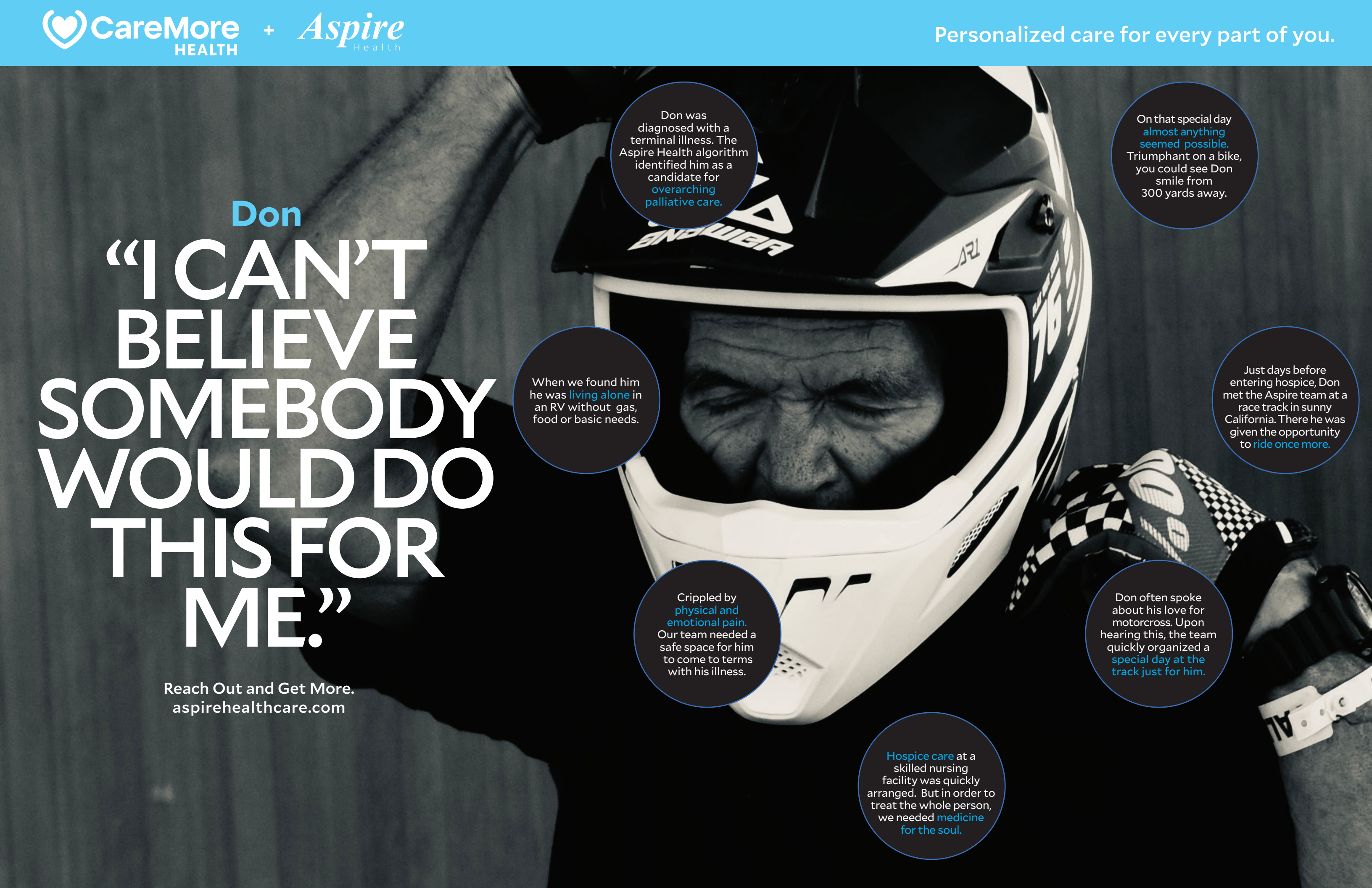

Voice of Ari Aspire Remote Social Worker:
Don is the kind of guy that didn't need to ask people for help.

VO: When we first came in contact with him he was living in an RV. He had no access to care or medications, suffering from cancer and chronic homelessness he was barely surviving.



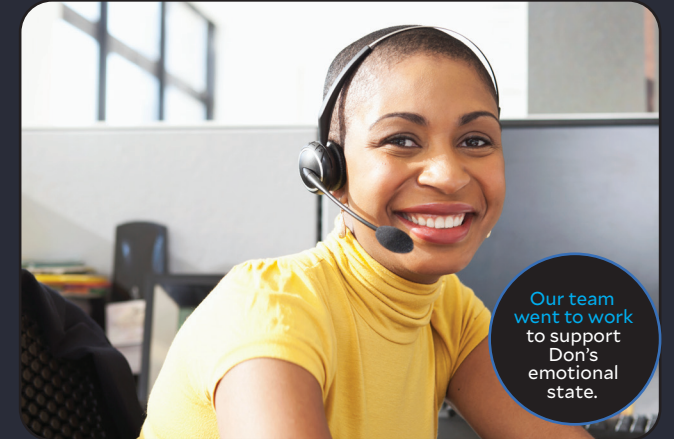
Voice of Ari:
Don was brought on to Aspire because of an insurance algorithm. Given certain risk factors patients are recommended for this overarching wrap-around palliative care service.

VO: Don needed a stable living situation and access to health care and medications.



Voice of Ari:
Don was in a lot of pain both physically and emotionally, he kept saying this just isn't me, this isn't the me I've always been.

VO: After his conversations with Nurse practitioner Ariel we discovered that Don used to professionally ride motorcross.

Very quickly we arranged for hospice care in a skilled nursing facility. But also Inspired by Don's tales of motorcross racing, our team of health advocates made some special calls.

They arranged for Don to ride motorcross on a track one last time.

On an open space on a warm and sunny southern California afternoon, Don and his friend went for the ride of their lives on special prototype motorcross bikes.

All thanks to a generous track doner and the team at Aspire who went above and beyond on his behalf.



Voice of Joe V.P. Business Development:
He was like a kid in a candy store, I've never seen somebody so sick look so good. But the smile you could see from cheek to cheek when he was riding 300 yards away as he was going through the dirt, that was great.



Voice of Joe:
I think the bike was such a good medicine to him, it gave him a perspective of I can keep going. I don't need to give up. It gave him peace.

Meet Rosa. Language barriers and a lack of transportation caused her to miss appointments and important medical calls.

Rosa had to delay several crucial cataract surgeries because she didn't have anyone to help her understand where and when to go.

A dedicated team was put in place to get Rosa the help she needed. It included her health care provider, a social worker as well as a Community Health Worker.

Rosa was surrounded with support. A Personal Care Associate was assigned to help her in the home with cleanliness and loneliness.


A Social Worker helps her combat feelings of isolation. And she knows who to call when she needs assistance or someone to talk to.

Her turnaround has been amazing. Rosa is taking control of her life. She knows there are people out there to help, and she knows that she is not alone anymore.
